VINEYARDS

Argentine Patagonia (39° South Latitude - 300 m.a.s.l.), Neuquén, San Patricio del Chañar, Route 7, Picada 15. Vineyard area: 162 hectares. Year of plantation: 2001. Rainfall: 197 mm/year. Temperature range: 20°C. Drip-irrigated vines on a high espalier, trained on a bilateral cordon with vertically positioned buds.

COMMENTS

Selected lots at La Papay Estate vineyards. 12 months, French and American oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Intense dark red color. Aromas of red peppers, berries and vanilla. On the palate, it is complex with hints of marmalade, dried mushrooms and caramel, given by the oak. A well-structured, elegant wine and a smooth finish.
